The Fall of Harvard Parallels The Fall of America

Harvard College was founded in 1636 and named after its first benefactor, Puritan clergyman John Harvard. Harvard is the oldest institution of higher learning in the United States and among the most prestigious in the world. Harvard College was the first non-denominational school in the nation.

Harvard's Original Motto

"Truth For Christ And His Church"

The 1636 Rules For Harvard:

"Let every student be plainly instructed and earnestly pressed to consider well the main end of life and studies is to know God and Jesus Christ who is eternal life (John 17:3), and therefore to lay Christ in the bottom as the only foundation of all sound knowledge and learning. And seeing the Lord only giveth wisdom, let everyone seriously set himself in reading the Bible twice a day that he shall be ready to give an account of his proficiency therein both in Theoretical observations of language and logic, and in practical and spiritual truths, as his tutor shall require, according to his ability, seeing the entrance of the Word of God giveth light, it giveth understanding to the simple" (Psalm 119:130).

Harvard, Yale, Princeton, Oxford, William Tyndale College:

Cracks in their biblical foundations soon led to the spiritual collapse of these Christian schools, churches and subsequently our nation. The Scripture cannot be broken "When the foundation is destroyed, what shall the righteous do? (Psalm 11:3)." "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables" (2 Timothy 4:3-4).

Harvard's New Seal Reads:

"For Christ and His Church" has been replaced on its shield with the word "Truth." Harvard now teaches that "... knowledge, wisdom, and understanding can be found apart from God." Students are taught that human wisdom is the ultimate authority. "Who change the truth of God into a lie" (Romans 1:25)

Harvard First To Promote LGBTQ Agenda:

Harvard University established the first LGBTQ faculty position in the United States in 2012. Peter J. Gomes (1942- 2011) the longtime gay Chaplain at Harvard, and Pastor of Harvard Memorial Church for three and half decades. He was Professor of Christian Morals at the Harvard Divinity School. Gomes prayed at the inauguration of Presidents Ronald W. Reagan and George W.H. Bush. In 1979 Time Magazine called him "One of the seven most distinguished preachers in America." Gomes was one of the most beloved figures at Harvard University where he presided over countless commencement and convocation ceremonies. When Gomes came out of the closet in 1991, calls for his immediate resignation were widely ignored.

Gomes Commendations:

Harvard's President Dr. Drew G. Faust (2007-18) upon the death of Gomes, stated: "Peter J. Gomes was one of the greatest preachers of our generation, and a living symbol of courage and conviction." "No one epitomizes all that is good about Harvard more than Peter J. Gomes," said Professor Henry Louis Gates Jr. A longtime friend and Divinity School Professor Emeritus Preston N. Williams said: "I think he is the greatest of the clergy men that Harvard has had. When it came to Christian morals, he did a number one job for the University." "Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil" (Isa. 5:20).

Harvard First To Install an Atheist as Chief Chaplain:

Harvard University's more than 40 chaplains have unanimously (2021) elected an atheist to be the new president of its Chaplain's organization. Greg Epstein, 44, a Jew, was raised in a Jewish family. Upon his election, he stated: "I'll be teaching students about the progressive movement that centers people's relationship with one another instead with God. We don't look to a god for answers, we are each other's answers."

Most Christian Colleges and Churches are Compromised:

Ken Ham's excellent book "Already Compromised" is a well-written expose of a dirty little secret: "Many so-called Christian colleges are as destructive to the faith of young college students as secular colleges. These "Christian" colleges undermine their students with doubts about the Bible. Many Christian colleges are Christian in name only.
