Civil Rights Hijacked By Race Hustlers – 2

“Black Votes Matter To Many Politicians – More So Than Black Lives. That is Why Such Politicians Must Try To Keep Black Voters Fearful, Angry And Resentful. Racial Harmony Would Be Political Disaster For Such Politicians.” *Dr. Thomas Sowell*

Blacks And The Democratic Party:

Blacks mostly voted Republican from after the Civil War and through the early part of the 20th century. That’s not surprising when one considers that Abraham was the first Republican president, and the white, segregationist politicians who governed Southern states in those days were Democrats. The Democratic Party didn’t welcome blacks then, and it wasn’t until 1924 that blacks were even permitted to attend Democratic conventions in any official capacity. Most blacks lived in the South, where they were mostly prevented from voting at all. The election of Roosevelt in 1932 marked the beginning of a change. He got 75 percent of the black vote for president in 1936.

Roosevelt on Race:

➤ **Medical Racism:**

President Franklin Roosevelt – a polio victim – founded the Georgia Warm Springs Foundation for polio rehabilitation in 1927. In keeping with the Jim Crow practices of the time, Warm Springs was open **only** to white patients.

➤ **Political Racism:**

The most glaring obvious example of FDR’s thoughts on race was his Appointments of Klansmen to the U.S. Supreme Court: James Byrnes and Hugo Black. Black’s participation in Klan events throughout the State of Alabama. Black was a highly successful Klan lawyer, he was known for using epithets such as “nigger woman” during proceedings. Black said FDR told him “some of his best friends and supporters were strong members.”

➤ **Social Racism:**

Republicans were appalled at FDR’s appointments, but his cavorting with Well-known racists went on. When he became President, a pact he made Required him to block anti-lynching legislation. It wasn’t a huge surprise when lynching rates skyrocketed, and FDR proved this with his nonchalant attitude during the whole ordeal. Did this darling of modern progressivism lighten up on his horrific racism? Not a bit. FDR’s administration denied loans to black families seeking homes in white areas. But, because blacks were hit hardest during the Great Depression, FDR saw to it that blacks benefited greatly, which caused 75 percent of blacks to vote Democrat, whereas pre-1936, 90 percent of blacks voted Republican.

LGBTQ Gains Recognition In The Black Community:

- With Bayard Rustin was the coordinator of the 1963 March on Washington even though he was known to be practicing sodomite. In 2013, Rustin was posthumously awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom by President Barack Obama. On March 8, 2016, Rustin's N.Y. City residence was on the National Register of Historic Places.
- **President Barack Obama Evolves:**

On April 17, 2008, while running for president, "I believe that marriage is the union between a man and a woman. Now, for me as a Christian, it is also a sacred union. God is in the mix.
- On November 2, 2008, "I believe that marriage is the union between a man And a woman. I am not in favor of gay marriage. (This time he adds a qualifier) "But when you start playing around with constitutions, just to prohibit somebody who cares about another person, it just seems to me that's not what America's about."
- On June 29, 2009 as president, "I've called on Congress to repeal the so-called Defense of Marriage Act to help end discrimination against same-sex couples in this country. (At an LGBT Pride Month Reception)
- On May 9, 2012, as president, "I've just concluded that for me personally it Is important for me to go ahead and affirm that I think same-sex couples Should be able to get married." (Interviewed by Robin Roberts, who was preparing to celebrate 15 years in a same sex relationship with Amber Raign)
- On June 26, 2015, the U.S. Supreme Court declares same-sex marriagesol are legal in all 50 states. President Obama's lit up the White House in rainbow colors.
- **Jesse Jackson Evolves:**

"I would officiate a same-sex wedding if asked."
- **Al Sharpton Evolves:**

"Today we can celebrate that the principles of justice and equality under the law won." (The day the Supreme Court ruled in favor of same-sex marriage)
- **ArchBishop Desmond Tutu Evolves:**

"I would never worship a homophobic God. "I would rather go to hell."
