Happy Mother's Day

Do Not Forsake Your Mother's Instructions

"The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instructions, hear, my son, your father's instruction, and do not forsake your mother's teaching; indeed, they are a graceful wreath to your head, and ornaments about your neck" (Proverbs 1:7-9).

A Daughter's Disobedience:

Seventeen year old Brittanee Drexel was last seen in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina on April 25, 2009. She disappeared after sneaking away for spring break. At the time of her disappearance Brittanee was a junior at Gates-Chili High School in Rochester, New York. She played on the soccer team where she was a star player. She aspired to be a model or a nurse. In early April of 2009, Brittanee told her mother of her plans to travel to Myrtle Beach, South Carolina for spring break with her friends.

A Mother's Premonition:

Her mother Dawn refused to let her go **without adult supervision**, and also because said she had a **premonition** that something bad would happen to her daughter. This argument lasted several days until Brittanee asked her mother if she could go over to a friend's home for a day or two to calm down. Her mother allowed it, but that same day, April 22, 2009, Brittanee left for South Carolina with other students without saying anything to her mother.

A Daughter's Deception:

On April 23, 2009, Brittanee called her mother upon her arrival at Bar Harbor at 1010 North Ocean Boulevard in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. However, she lied and said that she was at a local beach with friends, which her mother assumed was at the nearby Charlotte beach in New York State.

A Daughter's Disappearance:

On April 25, 2009, that evening, Brittanee was captured by surveillance cameras leaving the Blue Water Resort. Between 9:00 – 9:15 pm, she suddenly stopped texting and responding to calls and texts. She was never heard from again. Later, her mother contacted the police when her calls and texts went unanswered.

The FBI Confirmed The Families Worst Fears:

On June 18, 2016, the FBI confirmed that 17 year old Brittane Drexel case is now being considered a homicide. They revealed their belief that she was held captive in McClellan, South Carolina for 2-4 days before being murdered. They further stated that Taquan Brown, a recent prison inmate serving a 25 year sentence for voluntary manslaughter, claimed he witnessed Brittane Drexel's murder, on April 27, 2009, two days after Brittane's abduction.

The Original Purpose of Brittane's Abduction:

Taquan Brown testified that he witness Brittane being raped by Timothy Da'Shaun Taylor (16). According to FBI reports the original purpose of kidnapping Brittane was for the purpose of sex trafficking. Brown further indicated that Brittane was gang raped over the two days she was held captive. Brittane attempted to escape was caught and pistol whipped. But when the case received so much media attention, Taylor decided to murder her to avoid her identifying him. Brittane was shot twice in the head and they dumped her body into an alligator-infested swamp near McClellan. No part of her body was recovered.

Timothy Da'Shaun Taylor Suspected Killer:

In 2011, Taylor was charged with attempted armed robbery of a McDonald Restaurant a case where he faced 10 to 20 years. **He was given probation.** In 2016, 25 year old Timothy Da'Shaun Taylor was charged with interference of Interstate Commerce by threat or violence, federal authorities attempted to use "The Dual Sovereignty Doctrine" hoping with Taylor facing many years in prison would talk about the Brittane Drexel's case. **He was sentenced to 18 months probation.** **In March 2018, Taylor took a lie detector test, and failed.**

Brittane Drexel's Father:

Chad Drexel (Brittane's father) spent many weeks in the Myrtle Beach, South Carolina community passing out numerous of posters with his daughter's picture. And without knowing it at the time, but one of the people to whom he gave a poster was his daughter's suspected killer, Timothy De'Shaun Taylor. According to her father, it took place when he was in the middle of a road when a vehicle stopped. "I took a poster and gave one to the driver and one to each of the men in the rear seats. Then the two men in the back began to whisper. So I asked if they knew anything about my daughter Brittane, saying I am her father. They laughed and the driver, crumpled up the posters and threw them out the window." Later, an investigator he hired to help find Brittane confirmed that the driver who threw the posters out the window was the suspected killer of his daughter. *"Friends, Brittane was tortured, raped, and shot to death and thrown to alligators needlessly. And no one has ever been held accountable for this despicable crime. But one day all the judges, probation officers, the social justice gang and the non-snitchers will stand with this murderer before a thrice Holy God and be held accountable. KH*
