There's A 40 % Chance You'll Get Away With Murder In America

Startling Stats:

The Washington Post noted:

▪ In the last 10 years, some 26,000 murders in major US cities went without an arrest, according to a Washington Post investigation. The newspaper said police attributed much of their difficulty solving the homicides to strained relationships with residents – for instance, the officers may be aware of the killer, but unable to convince witnesses to cooperate. “Therefore, most crimes go unsolved and many victims don’t contact the police. **“The no snitch rule”** is more potent than life or death. As a Police Officer, I’ve seen victims at death’s door and would not give up the name of the perpetrator.” *KH* “The mystery of iniquity is still working” (2 Thes. 2:7).

The Boston Globe Noted:

▪ As Americans across the nation protest police violence, people have begun to call for cuts or changes in public spending on police. But these nor other proposed reforms address a key problem with solving crimes. Reporter Blake Nissen states: “My recent review of 50 years of national crime data confirms that, as police report, they don’t solve most serious crimes in America. But the real statistics are worse than police data show. In the U.S. it’s rare that a crime report leads to police arresting a suspect who is then convicted of the crime.”

NBC News – California:

▪ California will release at least 76,000 inmates 63,000 violent criminals and repeat felons back onto the streets in order to create “safer prisons.” About 20,000 of those inmates are serving life sentences. Former California Senator Jim Nielsen ® blasted Governor Gavin Newsom for using his power to make such a massive alteration without input from California citizens. “He’s doing it on his own authority, instead of the will of the people through their elected representatives or directly through their own votes,” Nielsen told the Associated Press. “This is what I call Newsom’s time off for bad behavior. He’s putting us all at greater risk and there seems to be no end to the degree to which he wants to do that.” This will only add to the nearly 50,000 unsolved murders already on the books. The Illegals will maintain the status quo. *KH*

Chicago Tribune Noted:

Chicago's Fraternal Order of Police issued a vote of no-confidence in Mayor Lori Lightfoot citing poor work conditions and the cancellation of a march for fallen officers due to the coronavirus pandemic. "It was a slap in the face to every department member, especially the Gold Star families who paid the ultimate sacrifice and deserve that respect annually," he said, "Period. No excuse." The vote by the police union, as well as police Superintendent David Brown and First Deputy Eric Carter, was unanimous among as many as 200 active and retired rank-and-file officers. Reasons cited for the move reportedly include officer burnout and the department's decision to cancel off days for cops on several occasions – as well as a move from 8 ½ hour shifts to 12-hour work periods in preparation for possible unrest in the city." Other detrimental stats:

- During the Al Capone years: (1920s – 1930s)
 - . 200 – 300 people were murdered in Chicago
- During the drug-gangs years: (1970 -2021)
 - . 25,000 people were murdered by drug-gangs alone
- In 2020 74% of homicides went unsolved

New York City:

2020 marked the third year in a row which homicides rose in the city and why?

- . **No or Low bail for violent felons**
- . **The Mayor's disbandment of its plainclothes unit**
- . **Attacks on Police Officers downgraded to misdemeanors**
- . **The largest number of police retirements and resignations in the nation**
- . **The Mayor's full embrace of BLM, Antifa and the LGBTQ agenda**
- . **New York City is second only to Los Angeles in road rage shootings**

Detroit, Michigan:

According to a recent Time Magazine Spotlight on Detroit, 70% of Detroit's homicides go unsolved. Detroit homicides were up 30%. Detroit for the third year in a row leads the nation as the worst city to live in.
