Exposing Modern-Day Heretics - 2

“But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not” (2 Peter 2:1-3).

The Word of Faith Heresy:

Word of Faith (also known as The Prosperity Gospel) is a doctrine in many Pentecostal and Charismatic churches. The movement emphasizes speaking or confessing life into negative situations. Prosperity teaching applies the Word of Faith in claiming the promises in the bible into wealth, health and prosperity.

The “Little gods” Word of Faith Heresy:

Kenneth Copeland declared this heresy in a prophetic utterance allegedly from Jesus, “Don’t be disturbed when people accuse you of thinking you are God ... They crucified Me for claiming that I was God. But I didn’t claim I was God; I just claimed I walked with Him and that He was in Me. Hallelujah! That’s what you’re doing. And I say this with all respect, so that it don’t upset you too bad, but I say it anyways: When I read the bible where He (God) says, **“I AM,” I just smile and say, “Yes, I AM too.”** When Copeland was ask to explain himself, he stated on the Trinity Broadcasting Network: **“AM I a god? Man was created in the god class, he was not created in the animal class, it was a gods class. ... It means that every one of us is built with the essence of God. Our soul is the essence of God, and that means that every single one of us has the potential to become like God and to heal, to bless, to do almost everything that God can do.”**

The Lord Jesus Christ Stated:

“For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many” (Mt. 24:5). Meaning: Many shall come in my name – Not in the name or by the authority of Jesus, or claiming to be His followers, and to be sent by him, but in the name of the Messiah, or claiming to be the Messiah. The forerunner of this heresy is seen in Isa. 14:14 “I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.”

“Jesus Died To Make Us Rich”

Unrepentant Creflo Dollar still says “Jesus died to make us rich. Jesus bled and died for us so that we can lay claim the promise of financial prosperity. Because of the cross, we have a blood-bought right to be abundantly supplied. God will take care of us even more than the birds of the air, which neither sow nor reap. All we need to do is trust in Him enough to tithe and give offerings. Mr. Dollar, who won notoriety by his request to his followers for \$65 million dollar new top of the range private jet.

Paula White Guarantees Trump's Second Term:

On November 5, 2020, the day before the election, Trump’s spiritual advisor Paula White speaks in tongues during a livestream prayer broadcast in which she stated: “I hear victory, victory, victory in the quarters of heaven, angels are dispatched right now, they are coming here.” White was chanting so quickly that each word blended into the next. “We break up this evil confederacy against the election of Donald Trump, against America, against him whom you have declared to be in the White House. We break it up in the name of Jesus. We loose confusion into demonic confederacy directed right now at this election, directed at the six states. We come against people that are working at high levels right now with demonic confederacies and secrecies and demonic plans and networks, we break up and we command that it be exposed right in the name of Jesus.” White later went on to claim that “Angels have been dispatched from Africa” and that she hears “the sound of victory.”

God’s Warning Against False Prophets and Prophecies:

“But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die” (Dt. 18:20).

Making Merchandise of Weak An Unbelievers:

This is the atmosphere in which we live. These false teachers, teach and preach for money. “Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them who walk so as you have us for an example. For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are enemies of the cross of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things” (Phil. 3:17-19). The apostle Peter states: “... with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not.” The verb “feigned words” means literally to travel, (like a traveling hireling) as a merchant on business. And the unlearned believer and the lost are their main customers. Don’t be one of them!
